#### 2010 Kindergarten Orientation

Plans have been finalised for the orientation program for children who are enrolling in Kindergarten for 2011 and for their parents/caregivers. The program will take the form of three information sessions for parents conducted in the school staffroom on 2, 9 and 16 September commencing at 9:30am and concluding at 10:30am. During this time the children will participate in activities in the Kindergarten classrooms. Some of the content of the parent information sessions are as follows:

#### Thursday 2 September

Welcome and introduction; school readiness; Aboriginal Education and community liaison; school counsellor role; and office procedures.

#### Thursday 9 September

Student attendance; literacy activities at home; Peer Support Program: school preparation; and school tour and library visit.

### Thursday 16 September

School canteen; student welfare program; Nitbusters Program; hearing support; and Reading Recovery.

There is to be a special morning tea to welcome parents and caregivers to the school on the first information session on 2 September. Also a reminder that the school is taking names of children for the Kinderstart Program which operates in Term 4. Preference will be given to children who currently do not attend a pre-school program. The program aims to familiarise the children with the school environment and routines.

#### 2011 Kindergarten Enrolments

Enrolments for Kindergarten in 2011 are now being accepted. Parents and caregivers who intend enrolling their child/children in Kindergarten at Ashmont Public School for next year please leave your contact details at the school office. Also as part of the enrolment process we need to sight and copy your child's birth certificate and immunisation records. The birth certificate must be provided before your child can be legally enrolled in school.

#### **Contact Information**

I would like to remind all parents and caregivers that it is vital that the school be provided with up to date contact information for students. In case of an emergency it is critical that phone numbers are functional so that contact can be made with parents or others named on school records. Recently I have had difficulty contacting some parents due to their phone numbers no longer operating. This is quite concerning when there is a serious situation occurring. Parents and the school have a joint duty of care for the

#### Head Lice and Nits

Recently there has been an increase in the infestation of student hair with nits(eggs) and head lice. These unsavoury critters are common in schools and require immediate attention to stop them from spreading. For this reason, and to increase the awareness of this problem in the school community, the school holds regular "Nitbuster Days". The next day is planned for Tuesday 17 August with all children being checked for both head lice and nits. Of course checks will only be carried out with parental consent. Checks are performed in a sensitive manner and parents will be notified discreetly if their child/ren has this problem. Please note that children are not to be returned to school until they have been treated properly. Advice on the correct treatment of head lice and nits will be sent home with children found to have lice, or can be obtained from 'Nitbuster Coordinator' Mrs McKenzie and the school office.
