Congratulations to **Tysin Besley** for winning the individual attendance award for perfect attendance in Week 7.



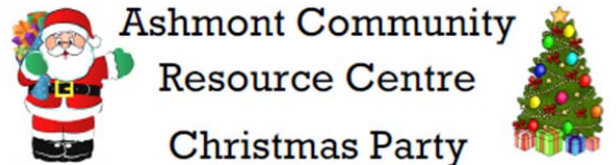
