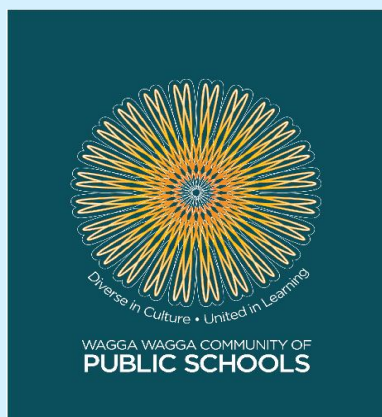
Volunteers

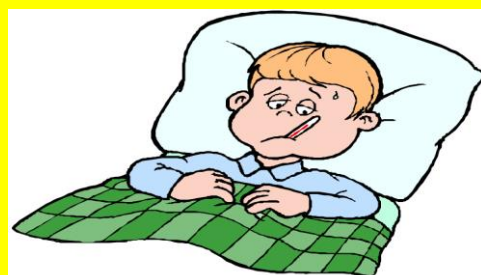
